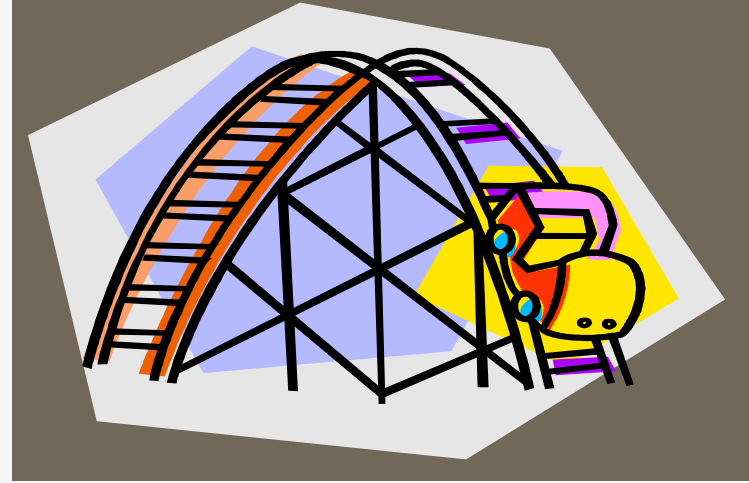

Why Globals are Beneficial:

- ALEPH **global change** mechanisms are used to maintain a quality database freeing up time for librarians to focus on public service. This session will identify which situations commonly require global services to accomplish the task.

Workflow for Global Request

- Write up request & create an ODIN Help Desk ticket
 - Provide examples which need to be updated
 - Include what change is needed
 - Estimate how many records will be affected
 - Provide report of records (if possible)
- ODIN staff comes up with a plan
- Global is executed in non-update mode
- Requester may be asked to check things out
- Adjust PLAN as necessary
- Run again in non-update mode or execute in update mode
- Requester checks results

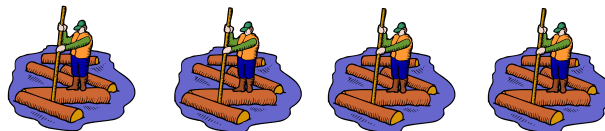
Types of Globals:

- Update Holdings / manage-21
 - I want all items in ??? Collection to be in ??? Collection
- Update Items / manage-62
 - Anything in Item Process Status ?? needs to be in ??
- Update Bibliographic Records / manage-21
 - I need 856 subfield z to say <http://wisherwasher.nodak.edu> instead of <http://nannonanno.nodak.edu>



Types of Globals:

- Delete items / item-11
 - Time to delete serial issues from my stacks because I only keep the current 3 years
- Fix Procedures / manage-33
 - My fiction collection doesn't have call numbers & I want each item to include the author
- Custom Services / such as custom-48
 - We want to clear the TO-DEL flag from our patrons

- Cataloging – ret-03
- Cataloging – ret-01
- Cataloging – print-03
- Cataloging – print-11
- Circulation – cust-90
- Print-11 will produce 3 reports & you give them the title
 - Correct 856s
 - Error 856s
 - Redirect 856s
- No report comes across = No errors

SQL – an Alternative

- Used when Aleph Services do not exist
- Examples
 - Update patron expiration date
 - Adjust ILL Total and/or Active Limits
 - Fix sequences on ILL records

Used when:

- 1) Size is under 9 digits
- 2) Data is suited for columns
- 3) No additional fields are desired
- 4) Custom Report

- Open an ALEPH module
- Run a service
- Move file from remote to local
- Double-click to open file
 - When file opens, the copy/paste may be done
- Scroll down to end of file
- Ctrl/A – highlights all data
- Ctrl/C – copies all data
- Open Excel
- Paste data into Excel
- Manipulate data

Excel / Copy & Paste



Used when:

- 1) Size is over 9 digits
- 2) Data is suited for columns
- 3) Additional fields are desired
- 4) Report won't open in ALEPH
 - 1) Note – Must be an ALEPH canned report “not” a custom report

MISCELLANEOUS

- Fixed fields (006, 007, 007, 008, LDR) normally not globally changed but we have done this with a fix-routine & re-load of all the records.
- CATALOGER name should be used on global change workforms otherwise Aleph sets cataloger name to 'BATCH-UPD'
- Always ask – we may not be able to do something but if you don't ask, we can't help
