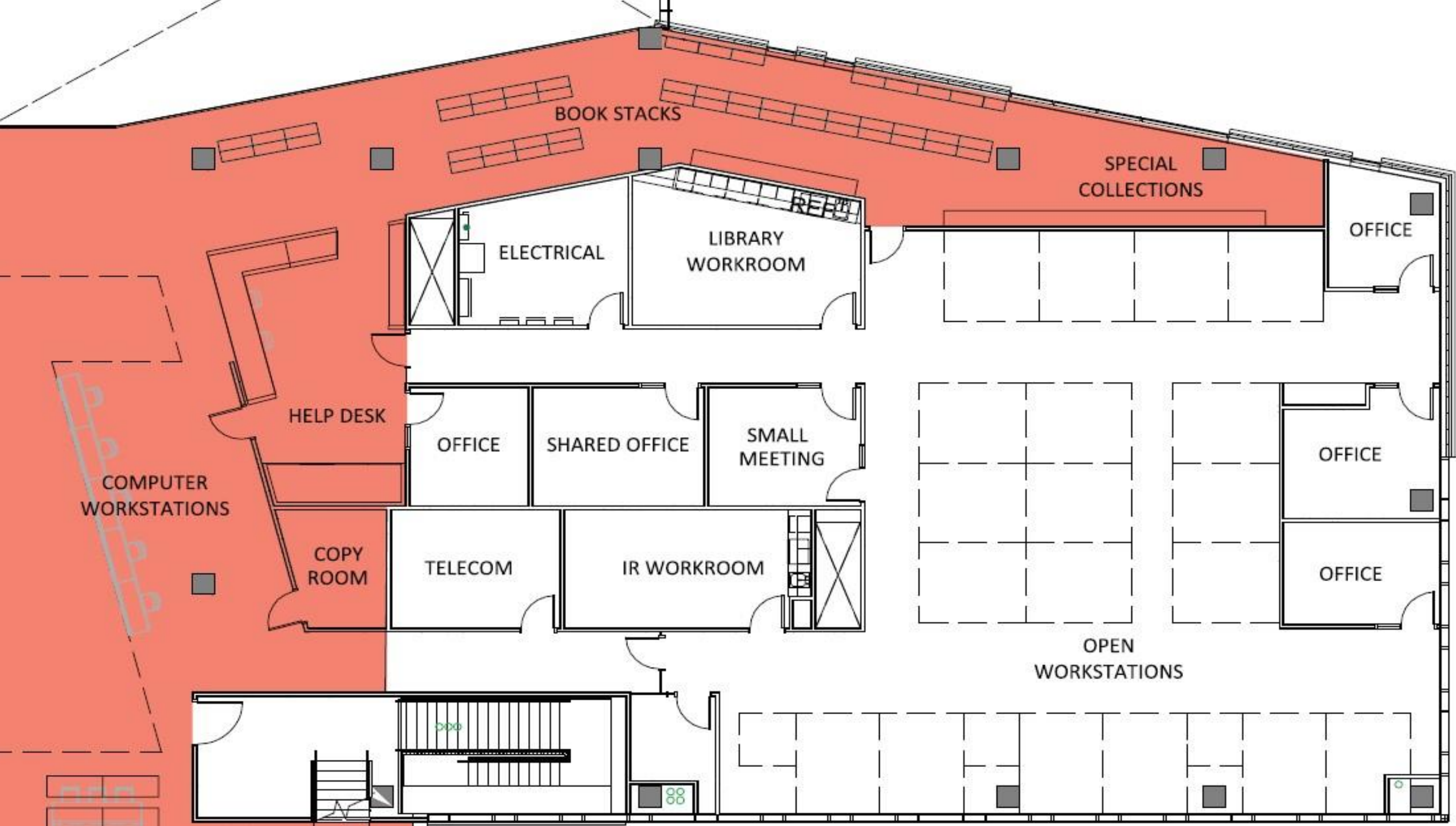

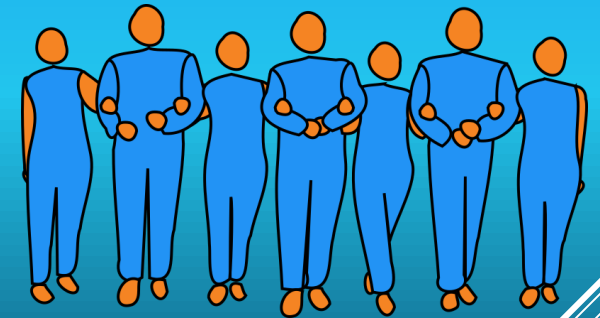

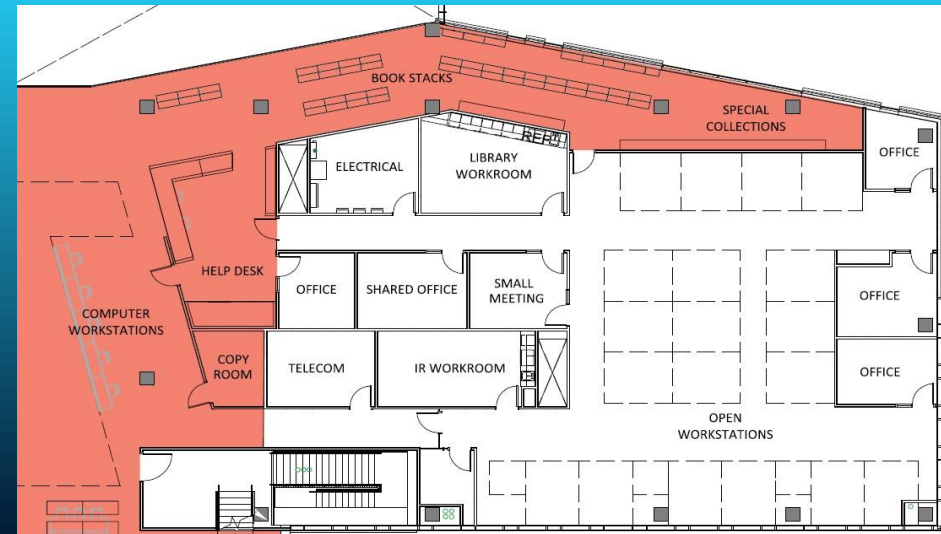
# SPACE REDUCTION

## 78% Reduction in Public Space and Collection Areas

(Stacks; Study Space; Public Computers; Reference, Circulation, and Photocopy Areas)

Current Library = 14,675 square feet

New Library = 3,300 square feet
