Social media has a significant impact on children's mental health, with various studies highlighting both positive and negative aspects. The use of social media among adolescents with eating disorders can exacerbate their condition, as platforms often promote harmful content related to body image and weight ². This unsupervised sharing of content can trigger individuals already struggling with eating disorders, emphasizing the need for safer online environments ². Additionally, social media can influence parents' anxiety and depression, which in turn can affect their children's mental health ⁴. Factors such as behavioral intention to use social media, enjoyment, trust, ease of use, usefulness, and social influences play a role in this relationship ⁶. On the positive side, social media can provide a sense of belonging and facilitate help-seeking behaviors among youth struggling with mental health issues ⁵. However, current content moderation practices on social media platforms may hinder these positive impacts by censoring mental health-related content ⁶. This censorship can lead to the isolation of at-risk youth and limit access to valuable resources and support networks ⁵.



Today CDI supports cross searching of various forms of the same word using the following linguistic features:

- Stemming or Lemmatization examples: book vs books
- Spelling Normalization example: theater (American spelling) vs theatre (British spelling)
- Character Normalization (including handling of diacritics) examples: fiancé vs fiance, 横浜 vs 横濱
- Compound Words example: healthcare vs health care
- Synonyms example: ordenador vs computadora
- Casing Normalization example: Book vs book

CDI's new verbatim search feature turns off the crosssearching of these variations, except casing variations
