 - 2307 Review, report, and restrict library materials



Alma Updates




CERV (Formerly NERS)

- First Round for Alma and Primo is finishing
- 238 ideas for Alma; 89 for Primo
- ODIN has 100 points for each
 - Cast our initial votes for Resource Sharing and Circulation enhancements this morning
- Member libraries can also join ELUNA for additional points

2025 CERV Timeline Upcoming Dates:

- April 9-April 10: Top voted results will be reviewed by the Enhancement Teams, then sent to Ex Libris to scope solutions and assign development points.
- April 11-June 6: Ex Libris will assign development points based on the complexity of each enhancement.
 More complex = more development points assigned.
- June 16-June 29: For Alma, an additional round of voting will take place. For Primo, the Enhancement team will determine if another round of voting is required. Once all voting rounds are completed, the winning enhancements will be announced and submitted to Ex Libris.
- After July 1: Ex Libris will deliver the accepted enhancements within one year, customarily by the next September (2026).


Primo NDE UI

- Changes to UI and 'under the hood' of Primo
- Early Adoption available must decide by 4/20/25
- Consortia ready November 2025

February Feature Release

- Al Improvements:
 - Metadata Assistant (Alma) fully available – still a 'work in progress'
 - Research Assistant (Primo) material type and date options for patrons
- Linked Open Data Enhancements in Primo
- New Patron Services UI is the default (only option after May release)






Polaris 7.7 Installed in January

- New Find Tool Features Sticky filters, recent search history, multiselect
- Non-blocking notices are now optional (no popups)
- Create a record set from Simply Reports
- Advances in Cataloging in LEAP keyboard shortcuts, duplicate checks, and comparing bib records



Polaris 7.8 (Q2 2025)

- Managing Import Profiles in LEAP
- Manage Multiple Printer Profiles in LEAP (receipt printer AND label printer)
- Student Record Import in LEAP

 - Subscription-based models are still available with expanded options


- Rialto Changes

LX Starter Update (enhanced email notices)


- Started our roll out to libraries –

SMS Update

- RFP completed and working on contract language and terms
- Hoping to sign this week
- Expected to have solution in production 17 weeks after contract execution (late July/early August, 2025)
- Chosen solution has expressed interest in providing solution for Alma as well
- Background
 - Major carriers are starting to restrict/no longer support Application to Patron (A2P) email to text.
 - Sprint/T-mobile began late last summer
 - AT&T has announced plans for this June
 - NOTE: We can bulk change notices to be email AND text, instead of text preferred alone.


Overdrive/Libby Authentication (Polaris)

- Working on profile cleanup with Overdrive
- Main profile will enforce barcode and pin after the change
- Patrons should not see any difference, but will need to log back into Libby after
- If your library currently does not require pins/passwords and is on this list, reach out.
